We support **six adults** with autism, learning disabilities, Tourette's syndrome and associated challenging behaviour.

Our beautiful home has **six double bedrooms**, each with en-suite bathrooms - great for private personal care needs.

The people we support have access to shared **communal areas**, including two large lounge-diners and a kitchen.

We have a **spacious garden** to the rear of the home with a patio area - perfect for enjoying in the warmer months. We love hosting garden parties for the people we support to enjoy! Our garden is also home to our **beautiful summer house**, providing an extra space for relaxation and socialising!

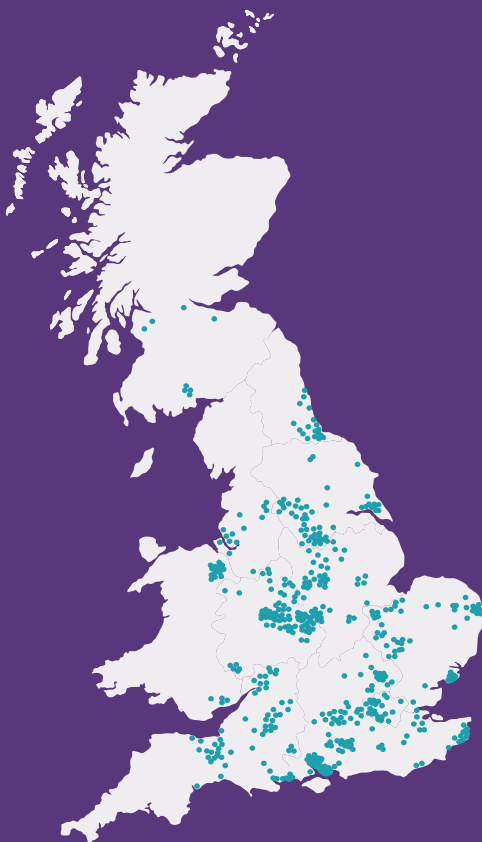
