Our home is made up of 11 bedrooms, spread across two floors with the first floor rooms accessible via **lift**. Feeling sociable? 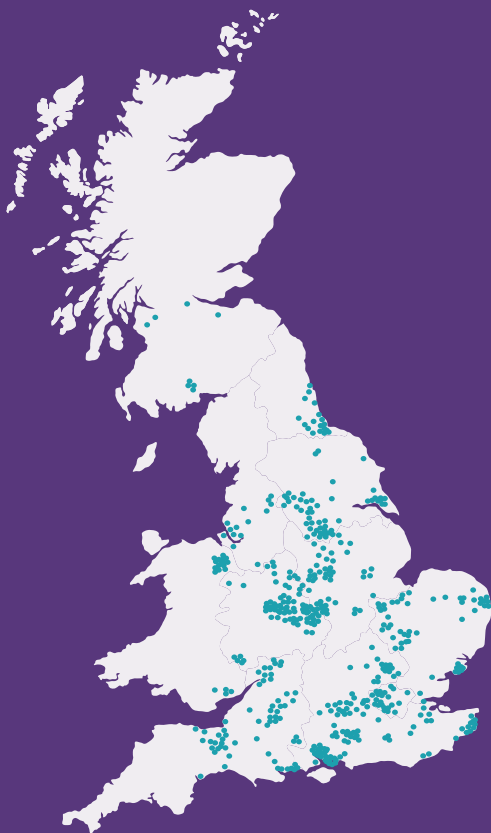
