Mountain Ash is a residential care home in Hastings, East Sussex. We provide **high-quality support for up to 10 people** with cerebral palsy, epilepsy and learning disabilities.

Our spacious bungalow features 10 bedrooms with height adjustable beds. We have lots of **shared communal areas**, including two large living rooms, a kitchen and dining room - perfect for taking part in activities with other housemates.

If you have sensory needs, or just want a space to relax, we've also got a **sensory room** kitted out with fibre optic lights, a ball pool and other sensory equipment.

Our home benefits from an **indoor swimming pool**, ideal for hydrotherapy or simply for the people we support to enjoy. Both our indoor swimming pool and sensory room are fitted with tracking hoists to support those with mobility issues.





A place to call home

Our home offers bespoke activities tailored to meet the needs of the people we support. To assist with accessing community activities, we have an **on-site vehicle** that can occupy those using a wheelchair.

Throughout the year, we host **different theme days** where the people we support can dress up and enjoy fun activities.

We encourage individuals to **engage in community activities** such as visiting local shops, leisurely walks and attending organised events like BBQs.

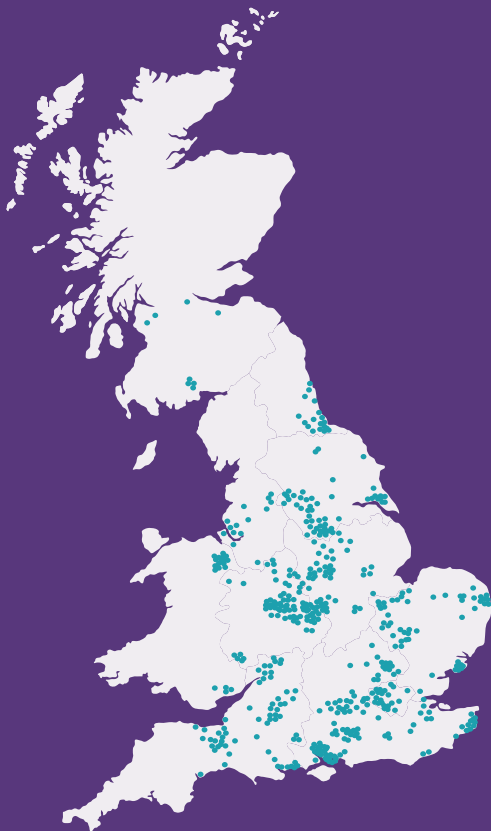
