There are also two flats attached to the main house, perfect for those looking for more independence. Our home has **lovely communal areas** to relax and socialise in, such as our living room, kitchen / diner, activity room and spacious garden!

514 Arnold Road is **fully adapted for individuals with physical disabilities**. We have tracking hoists in each bedroom, a lift, wide corridors, and adjustable beds.

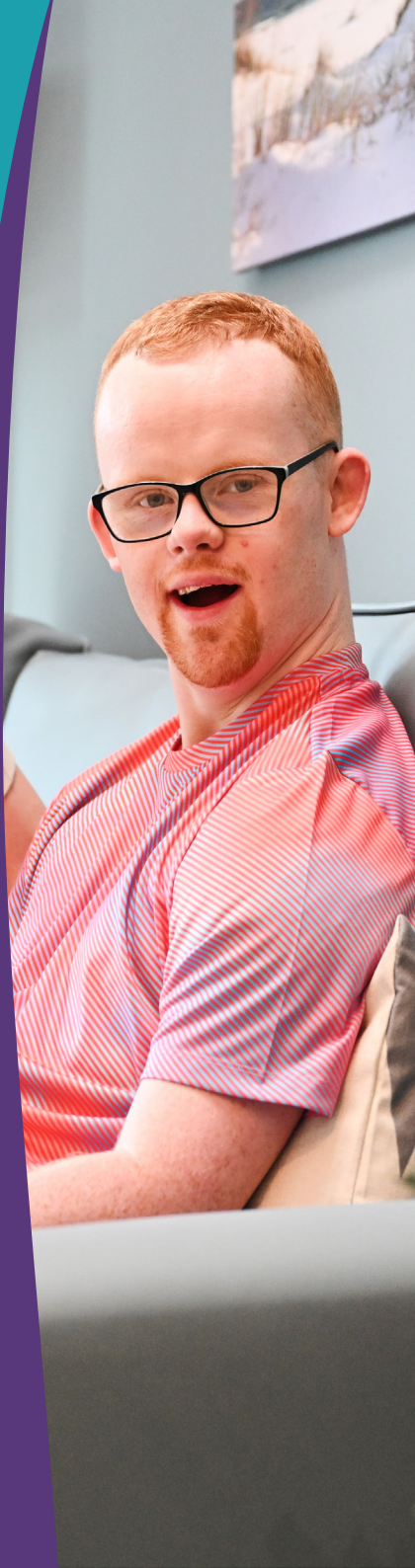

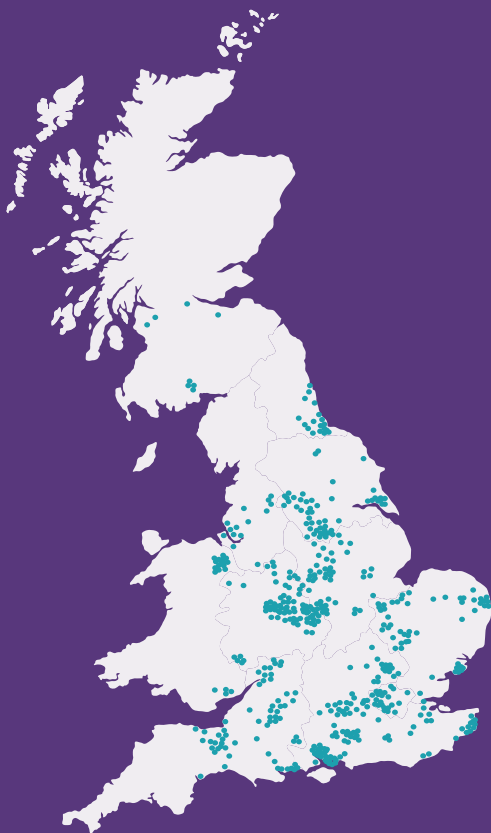
